Make leaf rubbings with tree leaves.

Try some forest bathing!

Challenge: Find 10 different kinds of leaves all from different plants!

Poet-tree: Write a poem about a tree!

Create a tree identification book.

Make a snack in the shape of a tree.

Find out what different animals live in trees.

Find 4 different shades of green leaves.

How big is your tree? Find a tree and measure it!

Relax with some seed to tree yoga.

Step outside and count how many trees you can see.

Examine buds on a tree with this bursting buds activity.

Make a bird feeder to observe the birds living in trees.

Plant a tree! Use this guide to figure out the best type of tree to plant in your environment.

Stuck inside? Observe the trees you can see from your window.

Make "ants on a log" for a yummy snack. What animals might eat real ants from real logs?

Explore nature by listening to the sounds of your environment!

Find a tree with an interesting bark and make a bark rubbing.

The shape of things - find leaves that represent different geometric shapes.

Grab some friends or your family and act out all the different parts of a tree: roots, trunk, xylem, phloem, leaves, cambium and bark!

Go out and hug 3 different trees (look out for bugs and poison ivy).

What's the value of a tree? Calculate the dollar value of a tree.
